

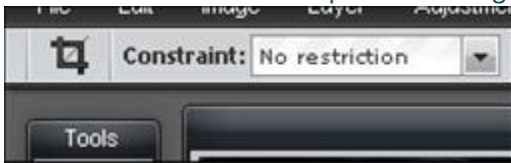
Here's the instructions for Using Pixlr for cropping and resizing photos:

After you've taken a photo and have it on your computer...

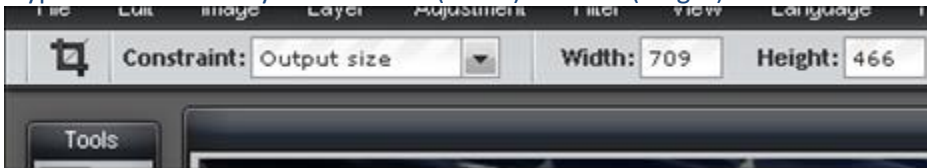
1. Go to <http://pixlr.com/editor>.
2. Click on "Open Image from computer." Browse to wherever you saved your photo and double-click on it to open it.



3. Click on the Constraint dropdown. Change the selection from "No restriction" to "Output size."



4. Type in the new size you want: 706 (width) and 466 (height).



5. Drag a rectangle around the part of the photo you want to KEEP. (It will lock in the correct proportions AUTOMATICALLY while you drag.) When you're done selecting, you can adjust the selected area by dragging the whole rectangle around, or just the blue corner handles. It WON'T LET YOU create a photo with the wrong dimensions! So EASY.



6. Double-click somewhere in the middle of the photo and it will crop it for you – **exactly** the right size.



7. Click on File > Save... Give it a good filename for the web – with NO SPACES in it. (You can use dashes and underscores in the filename, but no more exotic punctuation). The Format probably already says JPEG, but if not, select “JPEG.” Click “OK.”



8. Browse for the location to save your photo, and click “Save.” It is now ready to upload into Schoolwires!
